Admission to Greenfield Village is \$12.60 adults, senior citizens, 62 and over, \$11.50; children 5-12, \$6.25 and children under 5 free. Call (313) 271-1820 for information. During "Taste of History," visitors can watch foods being prepared in the historic homes at Greenfield Village. The chefs in these kitchens will prepare authentic recipes in the same manner as in the 1800s and 1900s; over a coal range, wood stove or open hearth. Visitors can then enjoy a "Taste of History" in a huge tent where, for a nominal fee, they can sample many of the foods prepared in the historic homes and kitchens of Greenfield Village. Adults and children alike

can participate in a pie eating contest, cake walk, macaroni necklace making, food games, and special auction where visitors can bid on colorful baskets filled with food from our past.

Some of the special foods being prepared in the historic kitchens during this four-day event include: Summertime Fare at the Henry Ford Birthplace, Cucumber Soup, Fried Oysters, Baked Beef with Sippets of Bread, Summer Salad garnished with nasturtium blossoms, and Baked Lemon Pudding.
