tants such as tobacco smoke, environmental pollutants and fumes from chemicals and paint. Not everyone with asthma has allergies, but studies show that allergie individuals are more prone to having asthma due to the presence of a chronic allergic inflammation process.

Avoiding the things that trigger an attack is ideal, but not always possible. Fall weather with its dry windy days and periods or rainfall make it especially hard to avoid ragweed, molds and other pollens. Ragweed is the number one cause of allergies in the United States and unfortunately, Michigan's ragweed level is one of the highest in the nation.

Asthma cannot be cured, but it can be controlled. The new focus on asthma treatment is to prevent an attack from happening rather than reversing it once it begins.

Learning about your or your child's asthma and deciding to take an active role in managing it is cited as one of the most important things you can do for yourself or your loved one. Knowledge is power. 



