## Symphony reschedules concert for January 31

The Farmington Area Philharmonic's "Rodgers & Hammerstein Evening" was postponed because of the snowstorm.

"I was standing in the parking lot Friday night at OCC, handing out notices of the postponement for those people we couldn't reach by telephone," said Karen Nixon Lane, conductor.

"The opening line of one of the songs from the concert came to me: 'His Name is Mr. Snow.' I absolutely laughed out loud. Even though my hands and face were stinging, the irony of the moment hit home."

The decision to postpone the program, which had sold out, was made late Thursday by Nixon Lane and the orchestra's board of directors.

"We had to consider all of the factors carefully," said Robert Heinrich, a board member and president of Metrobank.

"This storm looked like it would last well into the weekend."

The program, called "From Oklahoma to the South Pacific," features the vocal quartet SATB and covers the hit songs from the

five great musicals from Rodgers & Hammerstein's golden years on Broadway. Included are favorites from Oklahoma, The Sound of Music, Carousel, South Pacific and The King & I, as well as the signature tune for the evening, "It's a Grand Night for Singing."

The concert has been rescheduled for Friday, Jan. 31 at 8 p.m. The performance will take place at Mercy High School's 1,200 seat Clooney Auditorium, located at 28300 Eleven Mile Road.

Ironically, the postponement will also allow more people to attend the concert.
