responded quickly to the situation brought on by freezing rain late Thursday and early Friday.

"Typically this is what happens in an ice storm," Vagnozzi said. "I think we've developed a good relationship with them (Edison)."

Although there were several vehicles that had rolled over on highways and Orchard Lake, there had been no serious injuries caused by the storm as of Friday morning, Baldwin said.

"I'm just worried that a branch will fall and hit someone," he said.

Fire Lt. Mike Garr said there were a lot of trees leaning on wires, a concern especially if

winds were to pick up. And communication has been more difficult because the Hills DPW tower was knocked out Friday and a generator had to be used to get power back to it, Garr said.

Farmington schools were closed Friday.  
Hobbs said Edison had reported that although some residents would have power back by Friday afternoon, many would not have it restored until Sunday afternoon.

Farmington Hills officials urged residents to put branches of 4 inches or smaller out to the curb.

Farmington Public Safety officers were sent on 38 weather-related calls between midnight and noon Friday.

There were several reports of wires and tree branches being down. Limbs littered yards and sidewalks in neighborhoods south of Grand River between Gill and Farmington roads.

"There are lot of mature trees there and of course with age they get a weaker," said Kevin Gushman, director of the city's Department of Public Services.  
An Adams Street resident called to report a tree that had fallen down on a house, causing damage to the roof.

DPS workers were expected to remove tree limbs from city

rights of way this weekend. Property owners are responsible for fallen trees on their property, city officials said.

"If a tree or branch is from the city right of way, we'll respond to remove it this weekend," Gushman said. "If it's covering sidewalk, there are too many of those out there for us to get to right now. On Monday, we'll start cleaning up the debris."

Crows from Illinois, Ohio and Indiana were called in to help Edison workers.
