gency. A battery-operated radio, fresh replacement batteries, a flash-light and candles, a first-aid kit, bot-tled water and non-perishable food should be kept in a centralized loca-

should be kept in a centralized loca-tion. • Don't open refrigerators and freezers more often than absolutely necessary. A closed refrigerator will stay cold for 12 hours. Kept closed, a well-filled freezer will preserve food for two to three days. Partially thawed food or food that has ice crys-tals usually can be refrezen. • Turn of lights and unplug all devices like computers to prevent an olectrical overload when power is restored. Leave one light switch on to indicate when service returns. • Durn jelw-voltage conditions -nictures are smaller - shut off notor-driven appliances such as softigerators to prevent overheating and possible damage. Sensitive elec-tronic devices also should be

unplugged.
Disconnect house circuits from Detroit Edison power lines if using a portable generator. Pull or switch to off all main fuses or circuit break-ers to protect line crows working to restore service. Always operate gen-erators outdoors to avoid dangerous buildup of toxic fumes.
Stay out of flooded or damp in contact with outleta, a furmac or any electrically operated appliance that is energised. The water or mois-lectrically you could be electrocuted even if warning rubber boots.
Liston to local radiu stations for updates from Detroit Edison nhout electric service restoration efforts.
