star game until this spring.

"I feel honored that I was chosen to coach this game and I was happy to be here," he said. "I had a great coaching staff too and I was glad to be a part of it. You want to play everybody and I think we did."

Kalczynski said the only time his father - a tool-and-die maker who worked 16 hours a day - saw him play was at Tiger Stadium in 1959. He even pitched batting practice for the Tigers, so the historical stadium at Michigan and Trumbull has a great significance in his life.

"Some day maybe my youngest one will have the opportunity to play here," he said. "Certainly he'll have to work hard, but maybe some day he'll have the thrill of playing in this game as well."

"I played here back in 1959 and it's still a thing I remember as if it were yesterday. And I throw batting practice here for the Tigers from 1975 to 1982 and every time I walked in it was a thrill for me and I was going to be 40 years old at the time."

"I've been very fortunate in terms of the family that I've had and the people I've associated with on the field in my life," he said. "I've been blessed."

Khachaturian was one of 17 East squad members who enjoyed their Tiger Stadium experiences. Khachaturian started at first base and batted fourth in Kalczynski's line-up. He was hitless in two trips to the plate.

"It was a once-in-a-lifetime thing. You don't get to do this all the time and I really enjoyed it," he said. "I was trying and hoping to

make the all-star team, but I was still surprised when I made the team. I put all my effort into doing the best I could this year."

"I loved it. I had a lot of fun," he said.

Shawn Wilson (Brother Rice), John Wilson (Walled Lake Western) and C.J. Ghannam (Farmington Harrison) were other Oakland County players from the Observer & Eccentric area who participated in the game.

Shawn Wilson went hitless in two at-bats and John Wilson started at third base but did not get a hit. Ghannam started at shortstop, batted second and went hitless in two trips.

In the game itself, the East squad went out in order in the top of the first inning. The West squad then erupted for its only two runs in the bottom of the inning of eventual loser and recent Major League draft choice Ryan Anderson (Dearborn Divine Child).

Dan Hyatt (Summerfield) opened the game for the West, with a base hit. However, he was picked off first base and then Jake Butkus (Wyoming Rogers) struck out. So it appeared to be a routine inning for Seattle Mariner draftee Anderson.

However, Eric Doyle (Clio) beat out an infielder ground for a hit and went to second on a wild pitch. Doyle scored on a sharp single up the middle by Kip Harris (Midland Dow) for the game's first run. Harris stole second base and eventually scored on an error.

The West never really threatened after that as it finished with just two more hits off a corps of East pitchers.

Back in the game: Kevin Kansman, who retired as Farmington's coach last year, returned to the diamond Thursday as an assistant coach for the East All-Stars.

The East managed a base runner in each inning after the first. However, it didn't score until the fifth.

Kevin Burke (Trenton) walked and went to second base on Rumberger's base hit. Kevin Glenn (Detroit St. Martin de Porres) came in to run for Burke at that point and eventually scored all the way from second base on a wild pitch.

The East's next big scoring opportunity came in the seventh inning when Burke walked and went to third base on Rumberger's double. Dan Mlynarek (De La Salle) hit into a fielder's choice play - Burke was tagged out at the plate - for the first out. Joe Small (Fraser) then reached base on an infield error to load the bases. However, Steve Champine (Grosse Pointe North) hit into a pitcher-to-

catcher-to-first-baseman double play to end the threat.

Rumberger doubled again in the ninth inning with one out but the East couldn't take advantage and lost by a run.

"I thought we tried as hard as we could and the kids responded well," said Kalczynski. "I think it was a well-played game."
