POLICE AND FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

THEFT

In Farmington Hills:
A sum of \$500 cash was stolen from a cash box at Farmington Hills Chrysler Plymouth on Grand River June 30.

A \$1,650 gold ring and \$1,165 pendant were stolen from a Grand Court residence June 30.

A \$700 1984 Honda motorcycle was stolen from Gateway Apartments June 30. The bike was stolen the previous week but recovered in a nearby wooded area.

A \$599 Casio QQ100 digital camera was stolen from St. Paul Lutheran Church on Middlebelt between Feb. 20-21. The person who reported the theft wanted because he thought someone may have borrowed the camera and forgot to return it.

A \$200 Haro racing bike was stolen from a Little Valley Trailer residence on Tuck between July 1-2.

A \$300 mirror and \$200 23-inch color TV set was stolen from the fitness room of Village Green Apartments July 2.

BREAK INS

In Farmington Hills:
A \$100 Motorola cellular phone was stolen after the side vent window was broken out of a 1997 Pontiac Grand Am between June 24-25, causing \$147 damage.

A \$160 Motorola bag phone was stolen after the clip was broken on the rear window of a Ford Ranger parked on Pearl between June 30-July 1.

CREDIT CARD FRAUD

In Farmington Hills:
A person used a stolen American Express card to buy \$1,100 worth of items at H.A. Smith on Grand River June 28. The person ordered the goods over the telephone using the credit card number and picked up the merchandise later. The owner of the card said she was out of town when the purchase was made.

An employee at Harmony House on Orchard Lake was fired after he admitted fraudulently using a credit card to buy \$400 worth of store gift certificates in May. He would buy \$100 gift certificates and purchase low cost items and keep the change. Store managers believe the figure could be higher than \$400 since the gift certificates were

also cashed in at a Harmony House in Commerce Township.

OBSCENE CONDUCT

In Farmington Hills:
A 71-year-old Florida man was ticketed for obscene conduct after he was seen by passing motorists fondling himself while driving a 1982 Mercury on Orchard Lake and 12 Mile around 3 p.m. July 1. Two men driving a truck told police about the incident. Police stopped the driver who claimed he was adjusting a "bad pair of shorts."

AUTO THEFT

In Farmington Hills:
A \$10,000 1991 Ford Mustang was stolen from a Tuck Road residence between June 30-July 1.

A 1997 Olds Achieva worth \$15,700 was stolen from Bob Saka Olds on Grand River and Drake between June 12 and July 1.

ATTEMPTED BREAK-IN
In Farmington Hills:
Police arrested a Ferndale man, 27, for an attempted break-in at Botsford Hospital after a security guard spotted someone trying to unlock a door on the doctors' lounge by slipping a drivers license into the door. The man admitted taking a bag of Doritos and a plastic cup. He had \$3,235 in cash on him, telling officers it was his life savings and he carried it because his wife was being admitted to the hospital and the family doesn't have health insurance.

ROBBERY
In Farmington Hills:
A robber armed with a bottle of rum stole \$240 cash after threatening to hit a restaurant owner with the vessel.

At 10:50 p.m., the owner of Deli Man on Grand River and Middlebelt encountered a man inside the restaurant demanding money with the bottle cocked over his head. The assailant, wearing a motorcycle helmet, pushed the owner into his office where he found two cash trays with \$140 each.

After stuffing the money in his jeans pockets, the robber told the owner to remain in the office for five minutes and fled. The owner went to a nearby gas station and phoned police.

The restaurant owner told police he saw the same man earlier outside the dumpster and asked him what he was doing there. The man said the chain on his motorcycle came off. The man's motorcycle helmet had the

shield over his over face. When the owner and police returned to the scene, they found \$40 cash strewn on the pavement and an empty bottle of Captain Morgan rum. The suspect is described as a black male in his 20-30s, wearing a black T-shirt, dark jeans with white tennis shoes and he was wearing gloves.

VANDALISM

In Farmington Hills:
The rear window was smashed and a tire punctured on a 1988 Mercury Cougar parked on Renaissance, south of Shingwassee at 2:33 a.m. July 2. Officers questioned seven men seen leaving the scene who denied being involved, though two of them said they would be willing to pay for the damages.

In Farmington:
A section of a glass window was punctured at Shoe Carnival on Farmington Road between midnight at 8 a.m. July 1. The damage was \$500.

ASSAULT
In Farmington Hills:
A Detroit boy, 15, and a Farmington Hills boy, 13, were arrested after an 11-year-old Hills boy was punched in the face and another boy had a bike stolen after he also punched in the face by a second juvenile in the Byron and Inkster area July 1. Police found two teens who matched the description on Ontaga and recovered the bike.

BURGLARY
In Farmington Hills:
A \$600 .38 caliber Smith and Wesson gun, two \$100 watches, four gold chains, \$3,000 diamond ring and a red 1996 Ford F-150 were stolen after a break-in at a Halsted residence between 8:30 p.m. July 1 and 9:30 a.m. July 2. The back kitchen door was forced open, damaging the dead-bolt lock. Livon police recovered the truck in the Eight Mile and Telegraph area July 3. A gun case — without a gun — was also found. Police arrested a 35-year-old man and 32-year-old woman.

INDECENT CONDUCT
In Farmington Hills:
A Berkley man, 28, and a Farmington Hills woman, 26, were ticketed for indecent conduct after they were seen having sexual intercourse in a 1997 Chevy Blazer parked on 12 Mile and Newmarket around midnight July 3.

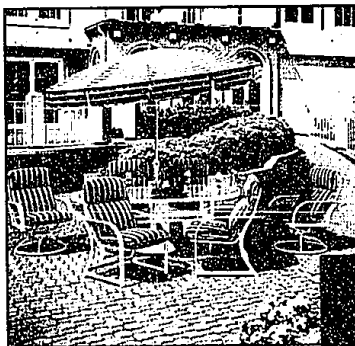
