Archery shoot for good cause

Outdoor recreation offers a healthy alternative to these negative influences. Unfortunately, not enough children are exposed to the many outdoor activities that await them. A group of concerned individuals have joined forces to provide such an opportunity Saturday in Redford's Capital Park.

The Commission on Children's Issues, Ted Nugent United Sportsman of America and the Timber Wolf Tavern have teamed up to host the inaugural "Redford Shoot for Our Youth" charity 3D archery shoot. The event begins at 9 a.m. and is being held in conjunction with the Redford Family Expo, which will also be held Saturday at the Redford Community Center. Proceeds from the shoot will benefit The Commission on Children's Issues, Ted Nugent's Kamp for Kids and the D.A.R.E. America drug awareness program.

Saturday's event will feature a 30-target 3D shoot, a bionic buck and other novelty shoots, a 10-yard youth balloon shoot, a dunk tank and a trout pond. Cost for the 3D shoot is \$8 per person. Shooters are also asked to solicit pledges from family and friends.

Leftover deer permits
The Michigan Department of Natural Resources announced that more than 160,000 leftover antlerless deer hunting licenses will be available for sale over the counter later this month. There are 68,971 general licenses available and 91,533 private land licenses available. The general licenses go on sale at 10 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 25 at license dealers statewide while the private land licenses go on sale at 10 a.m. Monday, Sept. 29.

General permits may be used on public or private land while private land permits must be used on the specific parcel of land applied for. To receive a private land permit the individual must provide the tax number of the land to be hunted (40 acres or more in Zones I and II and 10 acres or more in Zone III) and the telephone number of the landowner.
