Would you believe everything we just saw our mythical commuter do is available now?

It is, In fact, I've done just about everything just described. Don't believe me? I don't blame you. But to see for yourself, visit the website maintained by Intel (http://www.intel.com) and look up information about their "Connected Car-PC" project. These features are already available, based on existing technologies and standards. For about the same cost of a home computer system, Intel and other companies can hook your car up to do everything we described above and more.

I spent an hour or so experimenting with the Intel test vehicle. It was a regular Jeep Cherokee model that Intel equipped with an on-board Pentium computer system hooked up to the Internet through a cellular telephone connection. It was very strange driving and surfing the web at the same time, though instead of a mouse I spoke into a microphone on a headset and used voice recognition software to navigate the web.
