Gov. John Engler announced that Michigan will award local grants to help victims of domestic violence and sexual assault and lessen the incidence of violent crimes against women, including a \$223.674 grant to HAVEN in Pontiac, which serves residents in Oakland County.

"Michigan continues to be a national model
when it comes to dealing with domestic violence," asid Engler. "In addition to the most
comprehensive domestic violence laws in the
country, Michigan has been successful in
receiving additional funds to help victims of
domestic abuse."

Awarded to the Family Independence Agency by the U.S. Department of Justice, the federal STOP Violence Against Women grant provides financial assistance to develop victim sorviços in cases involving violent crimes against women and effective law enforcement and proc-

ecution strategies. (STOP is an acronym for services, training, officers, prosecution.) The grants to support local projects in Michigan total \$2.9 million. "Grant funds will strongthen the criminal

justice system response to domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking," said Family Inde-pendence Director Marva Livingston Ham-

mons.

Michigan will use the federal grant to fund 38 community-based callaborative projects that address victim services, law enforcement and prosecution.

The grant period runs from Oct. 1, 1997 to Sept. 30, 1998.
This grant announcement comes two weeks after Engler declared October as Domestic Violence Awereness Month and announced that Michigan state police cars will be displaying "Michigan is Arresting Domestic Violence" bumper stickers.
