Holcomb (backstroke) were the two Rice swimmers who earned state-qualifying times.

The Warriors placed a second ahead of Birmingham Groves to win the madley relay and touched ahead of Rochester Adams in winning both the 200 and 400 freestyle relays.

"Even if you know you're going to win the meet, swimming is individual in the end. So you're looking at almost every race being a tight race, and they know they had to get up in terms of performance."

"So, in that sense, it's not hard because our kids don't shy away from the competition. They're not afraid of someone who may be a little faster than them. They look forward to that because it gives them an opportunity to excel themselves. They get them up is not hard. They look forward to this meet."

Adams also looked forward to the meet and the chance to prove it is second best in the county. The Highlanders, who tied for second place at the county meet two years ago, accomplished that goal in fine fashion.

Couch Tim Hickey's undefeated dual meet squad was led by sophomore standout Christian

Vankerkay, who won the IM in 1:56.44. He also placed third in the 100 freestyle.

Senior Levi Larson, Marc Gray and Jimmy Ohngren were other top performers for Adams.

"We anticipated being second," Hickey said. "Brother Rice (winning) was a given, and we knew Groves and Seasholm would probably be our main competition."
