

**POLICE AND FIRE CALLS**

The following are police and fire incidents that occurred in Farmington and Farmington Hills during the past week.

**THEFT**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 A cellular phone and electronic organizer were stolen from a 1998 Lincoln Continental parked at Oak Pointe Drive the night of April 18-19.  
 Two bikes and a pair of \$150 basketball shoes were stolen from a Farmersville residence April 18.  
 A cellular phone and fleece jacket were stolen from a 1994 Plymouth Voyager parked on Thorny Brae the night of April 16-17.  
 Two cellular phones were stolen from a 1997 Jeep Cherokee parked on West Lyman the night of April 16-17.  
 A purse containing credit cards, a pager and checkbook was stolen from Wendy's restaurant on 12 Mile and Orchard Lake April 17.  
 An AM/FM cassette stereo and cellular phone was stolen from a 1998 Jeep Cherokee on Brimside Circle April 18, causing \$200

damage.  
**ALLEGED ASSAULT**  
**In Farmington:**  
 A 19-year-old Farmington Hills woman told police she was assaulted in Shiawassee Park between 10 and 11 p.m. Saturday.  
 Public safety officers were called to a Grand River restaurant where they found the teen applying bandages to her bleeding left wrist. After losing consciousness for several minutes, the woman was treated by CEMS but signed off on further medical treatment.  
 The woman said she was sitting on cement steps at Shiawassee Park, reading and writing poetry, from 8:30 p.m. Saturday until the assault took place. She said two men, one white and one black, approached her, with one of them cutting her wrist with an unknown sharp object. The woman could not give police detailed descriptions of the men.  
**DOMESTIC ASSAULT**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 Police arrested a Farmington Hills man, 32, after his wife reported she was grabbed by the

throat and then had her head slammed into the door jamb during a domestic dispute April 18.  
**MARIJUANA ARREST**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 Police arrested a Detroit woman, 40, after finding 9 grams of marijuana in a purse inside the 1988 Chevy Celebrity she was driving on eastbound Grand River and Pearl April 17. Police questioned the driver after she was involved in an accident and noticed the smell of marijuana coming from the open purse. The woman was also driving on a suspended license.  
**PICKPOCKET**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 A woman said her cellular phone was stolen from her back pocket while she was shopping at Kroger on Middlebelt around 9 a.m. April 17. She said the phone was clipped to her and remembers someone bumping into her at the store, but she couldn't give a description.  
**ATTEMPTED BREAK-IN**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 A storm door was ajar during an attempted burglary on Fox

Glen Court between April 9-18, causing \$100 damage.  
 A Wellington Street homeowner returned from vacation to find that someone tried to pry open the rear window of the residence April 10.  
**BREAK-INS**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 A cellular phone and a set of golf clubs were stolen after the driver's side window was smashed out with a large rock on a vehicle parked at Farmington Hills Pool on 11 Mile Road April 19, causing \$250 damage.  
 A cellular phone was stolen after the passenger window was broken on a 1993 Ford Aerostar parked on Bunker Hill the night of April 16-17, causing \$600 damage.  
 A gold chain, \$175 cash and a leather purse were stolen after the rear driver's side window was smashed the night April 16-17, causing \$75 damage.  
**In Farmington:**  
 A Farmington woman reported that someone broke into her vehicle through the passenger front window at 12:30 p.m. Sunday at Shiawassee Park and

stole a compact disc player and cellular telephone. The Sony disc player was valued at about \$200; the Audiovox cell phone, \$120.  
 A witness saw a gray Mercury Sable leave the park's lot, turning onto northbound Power and then onto eastbound Shiawassee. The witness gave police a partial description of the driver: a 36-year-old balding white male.  
**DRUNKEN DRIVING**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 Police arrested a Farmington Hills man, 29, for drunken driving on 13 Mile and Eastfield around 5:30 p.m. April 19. Police questioned the driver after his 1998 Ford rental vehicle ended up on the front lawn of a Eastfield residence. A witness said the driver lost control of the vehicle after turning left from southbound Orchard Lake to eastbound 13 Mile. The driver had a blood alcohol level of .13 percent, which is above the legal limit of .10 percent.  
 Police arrested a Royal Oak woman, 31, for drunken driving on westbound 10 Mile and Haggerty at 9 p.m. April 19. Police stopped the 1990 Mercury

Cougar after it was seen weaving on the road. The driver had a blood alcohol level of .33 percent, which is more than three times above the legal limit.  
**CAUGHT WITH CASSETTES**  
**In Farmington:**  
 An employee at Harmony House, in the 33000 block of Grand River, called police after a 76-year-old West Bloomfield man sounded the store sensor, about 3:40 p.m. Friday. Four music cassettes, "Classic Queen," "Tony Bennett," "The Best of Beethoven" and "The Magic Flute of James Galway," were found inside his suitcase pocket.  
 After going through the check-out line, the bell sounded and the man was caught with the cassettes. He first told police the tapes must have wound up in his pocket after another customer bumped into him.  
 Later, in a subsequent written statement, he said he simply forgot that he put the tapes in his pocket.  
**VANDALISM**  
**In Farmington Hills:**  
 A BB gun was used to shoot out a front window at a Yale Court residence between April 12-19, causing \$260 damage.  
 A bay window was shattered at a Trailwood residence April 13, causing \$350 damage.
