MARY PASCHAL KELLEY
Sister of Mercy Mary Paschal Kelley, 84, died May 17 at McAuley Retirement Center in Farmington Hills.

She was born in Rogers City. At age 14, she joined the Sisters of Mercy in Grand Rapids and for the next 55 years was an educator and working artist. She earned degrees from Mercy College and Notre Dame and studied art in Europe.

Sister Paschal was a talented artist who developed an art program in the school she attended as a child, St. Ignatius in Rogers City. Her murals adorn the corridors of that school and the McAuley Center in Farmington Hills, where she spent the last 12 years in retirement and prayer.

She served as teacher and principal in her hometown school 1973-84, where, according to her friend and colleague, Sister Catherine Sobek, she was "a gentle and laid-back but highly effective kind of person, well-loved by her students."

Sister Paschal also taught elementary grades at many Michigan schools, including Mercy High in its Detroit and Farmington Hills locations. In her early years, she also taught in Ohio and New Mexico, where, still in her teens, her pupils were older than she. Before retiring in 1986, she served as a volunteer at Bishop Baraga School, Cheboygan, and doing art projects for an Auburn area catholic school.

She is survived by sisters, Carol Violet and Dolores Blair of Rogers City and Frances Griggs of Warren; many nieces and nephews; and the sisters of her Mercy community.

Funeral services were held May 20 at Mercy Center Chapel in Farmington Hills.
