Farmington man goes to trial for armed robbery

A Farmington man's trial in
Oakland County Circuit Court
on 10 charges linked to a South
Lyon armed robbery is scheduled
to begin nearly a year to the day
after the robbery.
Defendant Kevin Tod Alexander's trial before Circuit Judge
David Breck will begin 8:30 a.m.
Thursday, April 22.
Alexander, 34, faces a variety
of charges stemming from the

April 19, 1998 armed robbery of Showerman's IGA grecery store. He is charged with three counts of armed robbery, five counts of felonious assault. Alexander remains in Oakland County Jail, with a cash bond of \$1 million, \$100,000 for each count.

Alexander's trial was held up because of forensic testing, the court clork said. "We're still waiting on the forensic reports" to come back, she explained,

He is charged with three counts of armed rob-bery, five counts of felony firearm and two counts of felonious assault. Alexander remains in Oakland County Jall, with a cash bond of \$1 mil-ilon, \$100,000 for each count.


