"Spare shooting is harder then ever especially when trying to hook the bail across the lane to shoot at the opposite comer. That's, mainly, due to the oil patterns.

"A, lot of bowlers are using a much tamer ball for their spare shooting, an older urethene or hard surface polyester which will not hook much regordless.

"Basically, there are several things that bowlers can do when they encounter changing oil patterns.

"Another thing bowlers can do is work on a 'B' release and a 'C' release. These are where you do not try to go for the home run, just get the bell on terget. There will be less power, but you are striving for more occurscy this way.

"Perhaps use a ball that is toned down, work on the weaker (8 & C) releases, hold the ball a little higher to generate more speed which can be an asset to your game as well.

"Regardless, play the line of predictability. Try to find a line that will got you to the pocket and use whatever skills you have to try, to get more carry.
