Rufus Wainwright carves out his own musical style

"In My Arms," featuring background vocals by his sister, Martha, and percussion by Sarah McLachlan's husband/drummer Ash Sood, takes the listener by the heart and twists it like a wet reg. For "Rufus Wainwright," the singer pianist chose songs from a pool of 57 writton within the last several years.

"I've been writing it since I was 17 or 18. ... It was quite hard (to choose the songs, Three are certain songs that I wish had made it on the next one. One song, for instance, "Liberty Cabbage," which was the first song I rever wrote, I hope that makes it on the next one.

Admitting to not knowing "much about pop," he looked to music industry executive Lenny Waronker and producer Jon Brient to help him choose songs.

"I would have loved to have done a record that was all weird; all the bizarre songs that I enjoy that aren't perhaps an accessible with a pop record. But you really have to listen to other people."

Wainwright said he didn't feel bad giving in to the record company's demands. After all, "when you're sitting in some gorgeous office with Lenny Waronker and he's telling you that you're going to sell millions of copies and then you'll be a millionaire, it's not much of a bummer."

While some musicians would never admit to getting a record deal thanks to their parents, Wainwright steps forward. Loudon Wainwright gave his son's demo tape to Beach Boys lyricist Van Dyke Parks who helped him ink a deal with DreamWorks.

Ironleally, Loudon Wainwright said during an interview with The Observer & Eccentric Newspapers last year that he wasn't thrilled about his son diving into the music business. Rufus Wainwright, laughing, called his dad a "liar"

'I think it's the left hand not knowing what the right hand was doing.

"Whereas my father didn't want me to work and stuff, my mother told me never to work. She said do net work, do not get a job it'll just bring you down. She also knew I was writing and she told me to stuy home and write."

In building his musical career, Wainwright took characteristies from both parents.

"I was really influenced by them, more by watching their, shows, They put on great shows. They are both diametrically opposed. My father's very brash, and kind of loud and funny, whereas my mother's quite soft-spoken and sentimental on stage. I think in songwriting I take more after my mother. Oat stage, I take after my father in terms of on stage persona and dealing with the audience.

His primary focus, however, is to render the listener helpless and take over their senses.

"The ideas that I used were to essentially seduce the listener, whother they liked it or not. Now, especially in these times, that's not being done a lot. There's just plan old songs. This is a melodious kind of thing that isn't afraid to be extrawagant. I had that in mind."

Legendary guitarist Joff Beck feels a little odd about releasing, "Who Elsel" his first album of original material in 10 years. "Who Elsel" features fierce guitar instruments, two of which, "Space for the Papa" and "Brush With the Blues," which were recorded during Beck's 1998 German tour. It ranges from techno ("THX138") to the appropriately titled "Brush With the Blues," and an Irish drinking song, "Declan."

To help him create "Who Elsel" Beck looked toward friends Tony Hymas, who produced the album and played keyboards, "Miami Vice" theme composer Jan Hammer, and Randy Hope-Taylor, a bassist formerly with the UK group Incognito. It wasn't an easy feat to lure Hammer out of his home.

"Texing to drag keyboard play-

Trying to drag keyboard players out of the woods to write music has been really difficult. Jan is a studio rat as he calls it. Ho's got his high-tech studio in upstate New York and you can't get him away from it."

Hammer and Hymns are veteran Beck collaborators. Hymns worked on "There and Back" and "Jeff Beck's Guitar Shop," while Hammer and Beck joined forces for Jeff Beck With The Jan Ham-

mer Group in 1977. An Beck puts it, the two returned to him for financial reasons.

They both have families and don't have the luxury of sitting around waiting for me. They, can't sit around like the old days when we always just weigh thungry. He'n (Hammer) get plenty of work to get on with in the menitime. I have to chose my moment when I can grab him to write for me. This has all taken time to plot together.

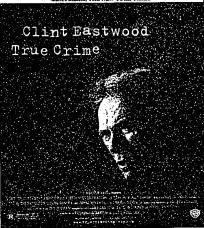
