

Cranbrook eliminated, Rice wins regional tennis crown

Don Brown does not really know what he's going to do this weekend of June 4-6. He'll be working at the Cranbrook Tennis Club.

Under normal circumstances, he'd be preparing for the Division 3 state tournament. But not this year.

For the first time in his 29 years as Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook coach, Brown will not be taking the team to the state tennis tournament. Cranbrook placed third at last year's regional and did not qualify for the Country Day, the Division IV state championship which moved up to Cranbrook in the Division 3.

With 25 points, Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook earned the second and final qualifying berth with 22 points. Cranbrook scored 15 points and missed qualifying by one point.

EXTENSION TO EXISTING BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX LEVY

The existing sinking fund levy of the Clarenceville School District of Oakland and Wayne Counties, Michigan of 0.75 mills will expire on December 31, 2004. Shall the Clarenceville School District of Oakland and Wayne Counties, Michigan be authorized to extend its sinking fund level of 0.75 mills for an additional period of four (4) years 2005 through 2008, inclusive, for the construction and repair of school buildings?

AUTHORIZATION FOR ADDITIONAL BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX LEVY
