

# Falcons hope to overcome hard luck

Farmington High is hoping to have its soccer team healthy and ready to play its best when the boys' state tournament starts Monday, Oct. 25.

The Falcons have struggled of late while trying to deal with a rash of injuries. They've been further frustrated by the fact all of their recent losses have been by narrow margins.

Farmington dropped its third straight and fourth in five games Monday when host Walled Lake Western scored a late goal to win, 3-2.

The Falcons also lost to Northville by the same score before beating Westland John Glenn. Then came a 1-0 loss to perennial power Plymouth Canton and a 2-0 loss to upstart Livonia Churchill, which upset Canton to win the WLLA Western Division title Monday, 3-1.

"We're going through some tough times," Farmington coach Luke Juncaj said. "We have some people who are not 100 percent."

"That's affecting our scores and play right now. Hopefully, we'll have everybody 100 percent soon, and we'll get back to the way we were playing early in the season."

The Falcons were host to Livonia Stevenson on Wednesday and have non-league games with West Bloomfield (tonight) and South Lyon (Oct. 22), as well as the WLLA crossover game (Oct. 20) before the post-season.

Farmington will be the host school for the district tournament that will include Farmington, North Farmington, Redford Thurston and Lakeland.

"We're working on getting everything settled by the time we start the state tournament," Juncaj said. "If that happens, we'll definitely be ready, and we'll expect good things to happen."

## SOCCER

The Falcons scored first against the Warriors when Aaron Turk sent the ball to Adam Lidger, who kept the ball on the ground with a shot that beat the oncoming goalie and a defender who failed to knock it out of bounds.

Western tied the score at halftime and took a 2-1 lead early in the second half.

With five minutes left, Farmington avenged the score on a counter attack from the midfield. Jon Kambouris crossed the ball to Matt Konopinski, who scored on a header.

The Warriors caught the Falcons "pushing up and going for the win," according to Juncaj, and were able to score the winning goal on a counter attack of their own with 3½ minutes remaining.

"There was a cross from the left side, and one of our defenders misplayed the ball," Juncaj said. "They got it inside the box, and a Western player put a 2-2 goal in the upper 90. The goalie (Matt Gasparotto) had no chance to get it."

Farmington outshot Western 15-7 and dominated the last 40 minutes of play, Juncaj added. "We really took it to them in the second half, creating many scoring chances," he said. "We had a lot of loose balls in front of their goal, which we failed to put in the net. Their goalie made several great saves in the process."

Stich was the case in all of Farmington's recent games, according to Juncaj, but the Falcons have been a hard-luck team of late.

"We've played very well and the ball has not been bouncing our way," he said. "We should have had two wins in our last three games instead of having

three losses. ("The results) don't indicate the way we've been playing. The boys have been playing their hearts out, and we haven't been getting any breaks right now, in each one of those games, we had golden opportunities, and we just couldn't capitalize."

Juncaj said defenders Justin Gerwatowski and Chris Holton have been doing a superb job, as well as Karl Lopata, Kambouris and Jeff Frederick in the midfield. Konopinski at forward and Gasparotto in goal.

Konopinski, a freshman, leads the team with eight goals. Nick Ramirez has six goals and Andrew Buck Five, Stephen Wayne is the assist leader.

"(Konopinski) has been a pleasant surprise," Juncaj said. "He has fit in real well with the older players and has been doing a good job."

**N. FARMINGTON 0, NORTHVILLE 0:** The Raiders played the visiting Mustangs to a scoreless tie Monday, two days after host Tecumseh to a 2-2 draw Saturday.

Northville outshot North Farmington 9-6, but had only two good scoring chances, according to North coach Ron Meteyer.

One shot came from a corner kick and the other a scramble in front of the goal. North goalie Mike Buchwald saved the one in front, and defender Dan Shumer, who was standing inside of the near post, knocked away the corner kick.

Northville was in control of the ball most of the first half, but the second was more even as North had four of its six shots, including two from 10 yards in the last 10 minutes. Brian Horvath saved the outside of the post with one.

"If it had been six inches inside, it would have been a win," Meteyer said. "It was a real fine game. Our defense really did a number. Kyle (Meteyer), Eric Phillips, Mike Leach and Shumer just did a number on their players every time the ball went out of play."

"(Northville forwards) Brandon Bethell and Tim Keliher are real fine players. Every time they tried to get inside, we

stuffed them out of the ball.

"The two teams stacked up completely. They're a little more diverse in their attacking game, but we had a stronger defense, so that balanced out."

The Raiders are 7-5-3 overall, the Mustangs' 7-7-3.

In the T-ecumseh game, North trailed 2-0 at halftime but scored two quick goals midway in the second half. The Raiders fought his way through three defenders with the ball into the left corner and crossed to Horvath, who buried the shot.

Two minutes later Jon Djokaj got the ball from Meteyer and lofted a long, long shot that caught the keeper on his heels and dropped under the crossbar.

The Indians went on the attack and pushed a lot of people up, which gave the Raiders some scoring chances. However, they were unable to capitalize.

With under five minutes left, a Tecumseh player ran into the back of Leach as he was facing the North goal. Leach put his back to the goal and the player falling into him, according to Meteyer.

The referee called obstruction on Leach and awarded the Indians a penalty kick. When told that level of infraction doesn't deserve a penalty kick, the referee changed the call and said Leach held the opposing player instead, Meteyer said.

The Indians converted the penalty kick, resulting in the tie score. "I tells the kids 'When you're playing away, you figure you're down by a goal,'" Meteyer said. "That one goal made the difference there."

Both teams had 10 shots on goal. "Mike Buchwald saved most of the shots very well, and most were from outside the penalty box and not much threat," Meteyer said.

**DETROIT CC 2, LAD JESUIT 0:** The Shamrocks (7-3-5, 2-2-4) fell shy of the Catholic League playoffs, settling for third place in the Central Division despite a victory Tuesday. Birmingham's other team and Warren Det. Jesuit clinched the top two spots for the playoff berths.

Patrick Griffin scored an unassisted goal and assisted on the other CC goal. David Rice had the other CC goal. Goalsie Eric Sullivan notched the shutout. CC came a scorching against Rice, the state's No. 1-ranked team, Saturday at Livonia's Whitman Park.
