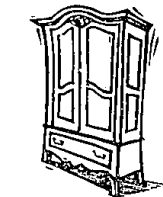

**Remember to recycle trees, holiday gift boxes**

The Resource Recovery and Recycling Authority of South-west Oakland County is reminding residents to recycle greeting cards, boxes and trees this holiday season.

RRRASOC will be accepting any type of greeting card (the entire card, not just the front) from Jan. 1 through Jan. 31 outside the RRRASOC office, located on the northeast corner of Eight Mile and Evergreen in Southfield. A container will be outside the office doors, so recyclers may drop off their greeting cards seven days a week, 24 hours a day during the entire month of January.

RRRASOC will deliver the cards to the Keith Boyarschen School in Warren. The cards will be recycled into new greeting cards.

Five RRRASOC member communities also may place bare, not bagged, Christmas trees at

the curbside for composting during the following times:

Farmington & Farmington Hills - Jan. 3-7

Southfield - through mid-January

South Lyon - Jan. 3, 10 & 17

Wixom - Jan. 5

Farmington, Farmington Hills, Southfield, South Lyon and Wixom residents also may recycle "boxboard" (cereal-type boxes, gift boxes and backs of toy packaging) magazines and catalogs in their curbside recycling bins.

Boxboard may be recycled by placing flattened boxes in their largest box recycled that week, or in a brown paper bag and set in, on or next to recycling bins year round. Magazines and catalogs must be bundled with rubber band or twine.
