Court, Michael Wiggins, deputy director for the Farmington Public Safety Department, said late Wednesday afternoon. He had just found out that an arraignment scheduled for 3 p.m. Wednesday was not going to transpire.

"He's not going to be arraigned today," Wiggins said. "The (Oakland County) prosecutor requested more information from us."

Until a warrant is secured and an arraignment is held, the suspect will remain locked up in a jail cell at the Farmington Public Safety Department, Wiggins said.

Originally, the suspect was to have been charged with armed robbery. But Wiggins said Wednesday morning that a preliminary investigation indicated a gun had not been recovered by Southfield police when they made the arrest Tuesday near

Telegraph and Nine Mile roads. "It came to light that we're not sure if a weapon in fact was involved in this case," Wiggins said.

The suspect could be charged with armed robbery if many losses or offenses," Wiggins explained, all predicated on the findings made by the prosecutor.

According to a press release issued late Tuesday by Farmington police, a man pulled out a black handgun and ordered the cashier to give him two cartons of cigarettes.

Witnesses saw the man leave the gas station in a beige 1998 Ford Taurus and provided police with a description of the suspect and license plate number.

That information was broadcast via police radio, and the suspect was arrested without incident by Southfield police near Telegraph and Nine Mile.

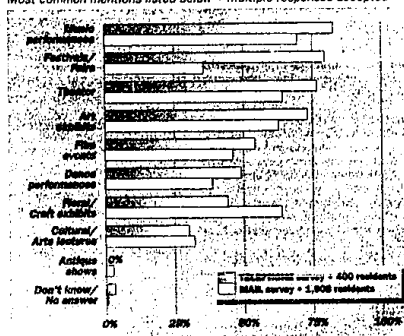

# Farmington/Farmington Hills Cultural Arts Community Survey - Aug. 1999

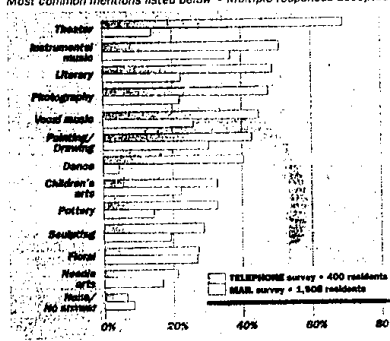
## Activities very likely to attend

happy to see that. It shows the results represent a good cross-section of the community, and also that the two communities were pretty close in their opinions."

The telephone survey was done to get a better statistical representation of the communities based on size. Farmington Hills has a population approximately eight times the size of Farmington.

People in both communities clearly value the arts, Coumoundouros said. The first survey question had to do with whether respondents felt arts are an integral part of the community, and the rewording answer was "yes."

Citizens appear ready, willing and able to both attend and participate in cultural arts event. Coumoundouros felt a vital part of the survey was learning how much citizens value cultural arts activities.

"This is obviously a community that is hungry for the arts," she said. "With the survey completed, cultural arts leaders will begin to hold focus groups, to collect more specific suggestions and ideas about current and future programming. Within the next few months, they'll meet with people from the business community, schools, churches and other specific interest groups."

The general public will also have a chance to comment at an open meeting, which is yet to be scheduled.
