

Adams edges Rice for county title

What is show?
The first Oakland County Boys Swimming and Diving championship meet of the 21st century set standards that will be tough to equal. In fact, many veteran swim officials can't remember a meet like the one Saturday at Royal Oak Meadows that wasn't decided until the final leg of the final relay.

Rochester Adams led six-time defending county champion Farmington Brother Rice by five points heading into the final relay — the 400-yard freestyle relay. In simple terms, the team (finishing ahead of the other would win the meet.

Rochester Adams took the early lead and held off a furious Rice comeback effort to win by five hundredths of a second. The Highlanders' first boys county swim championship couldn't have been more exciting.

SWIMMING

The Highlanders won with 279 points, while Brother Rice was second at 268.

"We couldn't have asked for a more exciting meet," said Adams coach Tim Hickey, whose Highlanders placed second to Rice four times over the past six years. "We know it was going to be close and we knew it would probably come down to the last event. You couldn't have asked for a closer meet than that."

Senior Christian Vanderkay, who already had won two individual events, got Adams off to fast start in the final relay by swimming a strong first leg and producing a body-length lead over his Rice opponent. Teammates Andrew Taylor and Chris Lutz kept pace over the next two legs to set the stage for the dramatic final leg.

Rice standout Matt Bowman jumped into the pool for the last

leg and immediately made up the difference. Bowman matched Adams' Jimmy Ohngren stroke for stroke, with Ohngren heavily coaching as Bowman for the win and the team championship.

"That was just an unbelievable race," said Hickey. "We knew we had to open up a lead over the first three legs," he said.

"With Bowman being second in the 100-free we knew he'd make a strong effort and we just hoped we could hold him off. Ohngren, being a distance swimmer, had an incredible 100 free swim to win."

Rice, which beat Adams by 113 points in winning last year's county meet, had more depth. While each team had one double-event winner in Vanderkay and Jefferson Moore, Adams won two relays, that was the difference.

"If we're going to get beat, I want to get beat like that. That was very exciting," said Rice coach Mike Venos. "We swim fast in a week where I don't know if we've done more work all year. It was probably one of the toughest weeks of practices we've had, and I was very happy with the way they swam."

COUNTY CHAMPION: North Farmington junior Adam Faber won the Oakland County championship in the 100-yard breaststroke Saturday and also earned eighth place in the 100 butterfly.

Faber helped the Raiders to fourth-place finishes in the 200 medley and 200 freestyle relays as well.

His teammates were Jim Gabriel, Jon Zaid and Chris Clayson in the medley in which Faber swam the butterfly. Zaid, coach Brian Diga in Diga were the other members of the freestyle team.

"We were real pleased for him," North coach Pat Duttile said. "He wasn't feeling real well that day, but he swam a good breaststroke swim. He had a good meet for us all the way around."

Faber was the No. 1 seed in the breaststroke going into the meet with nearly a 15-second advantage over the next swimmer.

"It looked like he had a good opportunity to win that event," Duttile said. "Nothing is for certain, but I wasn't surprised he won it."
