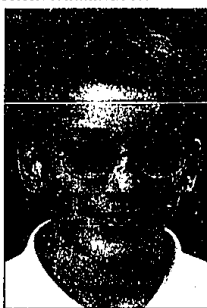
CARRIER OF THE MONTH: FARMINGTON

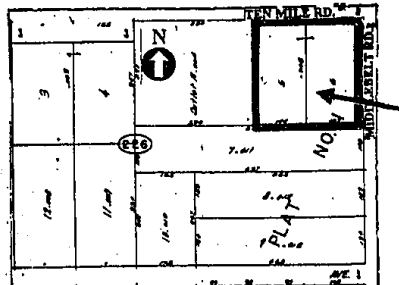
