

# FAAC art contest for high schoolers on tap

The Farmington Area Arts Commission announces the 15th annual art competition for high school artists residing in the Farmington School district.

Contestants should submit works of art original in concept and production for consideration by the jurist at the William Costick Activities Center on Wednesday, March 22.

Art works, no more than three pieces, will be judged by Barb Brownson, art teacher at Andover High School.

Art is to be dropped off between 5-7 p.m. and picked up that evening between 8-9 p.m. The Costick Center is located on Eleven Mile Road between Middlebelt and Inkster.

Separate prizes will be awarded in each category: two dimensional and three dimensional. First prize is \$250; second prize \$150; and third prize is \$75. Honorable mentions will receive \$50 each.

Entries are to be accompanied by a statement of design source to tell if the work is an original idea or if reference materials were used by the artist. Only individual works of art (no team collaborations) will be accepted. Two dimensional work should be unframed, mounted and matted, if appropriate.

All work should be accompanied by a completed label including the design statement as well as the artist's name, address, phone number, school and art teacher's name.

Awards will be presented on Sunday, April 30, beginning at 2 p.m. at the Farmington Hills
