Farmington High's boys track-and-field team finished first or second in five events Saturday and captured third place in the eight-team Relay Bays.

The Farmington team of Jeff Frederick, Drew Mortens and Trevor Moore won the pole vault. Frederick cleared a height of 12 feet, Mortens 10 and Moore 9-6.

Mark Ostach, Jawsin Sparks, Todd Anthony and Dustin Gress were second in the 400 and 800 relays with times of 43.9 and 1:31.7.

The distance medley team of Tom Eason (800), Mike Batkie (400), Pat Lockhart (1,200) and Chris Tobe (1,600) was runner-up in the distance medley with a time of 11:28.4.

Frederick teamed with Ostach, Gress and Anthony for second place in the 1,600 relay, which the Falcons completed in 3:35.3.

Farmington had a pair of thirds from Tobe, Bryan Giglio, Ryan Kiblawi and Dustin Gress in the 8,400 relay (19:44.1) and Gress, Spinks and Eric Gaughan in the 400 relay (55-54).

The Falcons were fourth in two events — the shuttle hurdles with Lukas, Frederick, Moore and Danny Preston and the high jump with Layne Bodily, Mortens and Spinks. Rory Crittenden, Delana Turner and Lukas were fifth in the discus.

"We competed well in every event, I thought," coach Chip Bridges said. "It was fun to be in a weekend meet and be in contention for a trophy. We hope it's a sign of things to come for our team."

Shamrocks down Falcons

Catholic Central rolled to 12 first-place finishes as the Shamrocks improved to 2-0 in the Catholic League Central Division with a 58-36 win over Dearborn's Child on Monday.

"I thought our kids ran well and we had a lot of young kids come through," CC coach Tony Magni said. "I think they've done very well in stepping up."

Sophomore Tom Grant led the youth movement with wins in the 110 hurdle (16.6) and the 300 hurdles (44.1), while freshman Randall Means won the 100 dash (11.4).

Aaron Velthoven took wins in the long jump (19-74) and the high jump (5-6); Matt Daly won the 1,600 (4:49) and the 3,200 (9:58) runs, and Mike Morris won the shot put (61-0) and the

discus (147-6). Robert Tymowski also had a solo win in the 800 run (2:08).

CC got wins in the 3,200 relay (John Daly, Tymowski, Jeff Haller, John DiGiovanni; 8:47), and the 400 relay (Means, Matt Gable, Doug Goldschmidt, Mike Mach; 48.6).

The Shamrocks finished fourth Saturday at the Dearborn Elks Relays.

CC won the shot put relay in 177.4 with Mike Morris, Charlie Rozum, Jeff Dweuke and Brian Jakkett. Morris, Rozum and Dweuke set a school and meet record in the discus relay at 439.9, bettering the old meet mark by 15 feet.

The four-mile relay team of Matt Daly, Jeff Haller, DiGiovanni and Dan Krawick won in 18:51.

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
