Lee didn't let it affect his play, however; instead, he turned it to his advantage.

"It made me play better, because I knew I was going to have to shoot better," he said. "I knew I was going to have to go as far as possible."

"That really made me mad and I wanted to go out there and show what kind of score I could shoot."

Lee's round consisted of six birdies, 11 pars and one bogey. He needed only 26 puts.

"I had one 3-putt, and that was the only mistake I made all day," he said. "I didn't think I had that good a chance to win it, but I knew I had to play well to qualify. I just put everything together."

Lee will compete for the state title in the Michigan Junior Amateur Championship July 25-28 at the University of Michigan Golf Course in Ann Arbor.

"I'm not familiar with (the course) yet, but I'm really confident," Lee said. "I need to play the course a couple more times. But, as far as the tournament, I think I can win it."

Considering how well Lee has played of late, nobody should doubt that.

"It was kinda scary going down there, because you didn't know what was under your wheel."

The elevation was similar to what it is in Durango, Colo., where Bowman trains, but the weather surprised him a little.

"It was pretty cold," he said. "Every day during training, I wore a long-sleeve jersey, and it never really warmed up. "Riky (degrees) was about the high, and it got really cold at night. In fact, it snowed one day. By the time of the race, it was gone."

But it helped the course. It was getting pretty loose, and that packed everything down again."

Bowman, who raced on June 9, and his teammates were unable to do much else but train and race.

"I thought we might have a chance to see a little more of Spain," he said, "to do more things as a team, but we pretty much went up to the ski area (about 40 minutes outside Granada) and stayed there the whole time."

Bowman was on the road again last week, traveling to Vermont for another national event on Mount Snow.

Following some races in Michigan this summer, he plans to return to Colorado and Fort Lewis College in the fall to continue his schooling and training.
