

Plymouth Concert Features Soprano

The second concert of the Plymouth Symphony Orchestra's 23rd season will feature soprano Roma Riddell. Miss Riddell will sing Mahler's "Songs of a Wayfarer" Sunday, Nov. 24, at 4 p.m. in Plymouth High School. Admission is free.

The program will also include the overture to "Tancréd" by Rossini, Symphony No. 2 ("A London Symphony") by Vaughan Williams and variations on a theme of Monteverdi by Walter York.

Miss Riddell is a graduate of the faculty of music, University of Toronto, and holds the artist's diploma of the Royal

Conservatory. She has been a leading soprano in the Toronto Opera Festival company and the Canadian Broadcasting Corp. Opera Company. She has sung major roles for stage, radio and television.

Miss Riddell appeared in Livonia this summer with the Schoolcraft Community College Court-Prestra.

Walter York, composer of "Monteverdi Variations," is a member of the Olivet College faculty. His variations are based on a ritornello from Monteverdi's opera, "Orfeo," which was first performed in 1607.



Medieval Music Is Concert Fare

Somehow the sackbut changed its identity.

In ancient Biblical times that was the name of a stringed musical instrument. In medieval times, though, the word had been changed to mean a form of trombone.

The latter type of sackbut will provide part of the musical sounds that will fill the Henry Ford Museum theater on Sunday, Nov. 17, at a special concert.

Members of Oakland University's Collegium Musicum will play the sackbut and such other ancient instruments as trumpets, horns, recorders, cornetto and rauschpfeife during the program, which is scheduled for 2 p.m. and 4 p.m.

The performance by students, entitled "Music for Kings and Noblemen," will be kept on an informal level, with a narrator explaining the music and instruments to the audience. The musicians will appear in costumes of the period of instruments as they play Renaissance and Baroque selections.

That type of music is heard infrequently today, but its lively rhythms and vibrant tone colors make it immediately appealing to 20th century listeners. The audience will be hearing those works Sunday just as they were heard as much as 300 years ago.
