Updated Beck: Guitarist and hot-rod mechanic Jeff Beck comes to Detroit's Fox Theatre 8 pm. March 13 to promote his latest recording that proves techno and aging guitar gods can mix – to a surprising appeal. On "You had it coming," Beck continues to strangle unguitar-like sounds out of his Strats. He lets loose his technical proviess over samplings, drum machines and other studio wizardry. Mixing time signatures on power chords on the lead cut "Earthquake" is hard rock candy, while "Nadia" displays his talents in producing far East tones from a guitar. The song "Rosebud" sounds rather Robert Frippish with its speeddriven scales. Beck is accompanied by some guest wocalists that usually reserve their chores to the background on a few cuts. This is above all a guitar record with a bite. While too many techno songs leave a plastic taste in your mouth, Beck attacks the genre with as much energy as a Kansas tornado.
