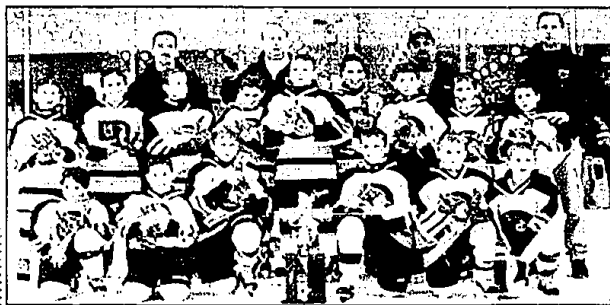


FHHA Mite Tier II champs
