**Don't Use Bad Words.**  
Almost every child has at one time been told, "Don't use bad words." It seems that in our society today there are more distasteful words than ever, and it is almost impossible to completely shield ourselves or our children from all of them. Children are great imitators of those around them, and their actions and language are influenced by what they see and hear. Adults may hear certain inappropriate words and will not be tempted to repeat them. However, young children often do not understand what they are saying. We all have a responsibility for our actions and our words and to display good examples to those around us. The Bible tells us, "Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for edifying, as fits the occasion, that it may impart grace to those who hear" (Ephesians 4:29). Our vocabulary is habit-forming, and the use of "bad words" reflects a disregard for ourselves as well as for those around us.
