"It's tradition," said Singleton, 20, of Highland Park. "You get to see all your friends. You see many of the same people (each year) and some new people."

Dines, 30, of Farmington, is on his 11th year of volunteering at camp. "I'm more thankful when I'm here than the other 51 weeks of the year," he said. "For someone who's never been here, you can't explain it. For someone who has been here, you don't need to explain it."
