the late, antierless-only season. Held in December on private land, last year nearly all private land in the entire Lower Peninsula was open. Due mostly to concerns of mature bucks that have lost their antiers being harvested during this season, the DNR has eliminated the hunt in five counties to perform a study. The idea is that some hunters purposely wait until the late season arrives to fill their antierless permit.

closed to study the impact of the late season are Ogemaw, Gladwin, Newayge, Ingham and Branch. Counties closed because they are within 10 percent of the desired population are Missaukee, Arenac, Bay, Huron, Oceana, Gratiot, Shiawassee, Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, and Berrien.

Be sure to pay attention to the details when you apply for a permit. There is once again a three permit limit, per person. The exception here is in the 12 counties that have had a confirmed case of tuberculosis in a white-toiled deer, where there is no limit. Left-ever license sales will be held in September.
