the zone meet; Bachrouche is going for the second year in a row.

Bachrouche, who attends Warner Middle School, qualified for the 100 backstroke in the 11-12 age group, swimming 1:17.91 at the Ann Arbor Summer Invitational to beat the qualifying standard of 1:18.19.

In the 9-10 age group last year, Bachrouche competed in four events — her best finish being ninth place in the 100

back. She also swam the 100 and 200 free and the 100 butterfly.

In addition to the regular pool events, the girls will take part in an open-water swim Monday on Crooked Lake in Springfield Township.

Bachrouche will swim a mile and Cohagan a half mile in the USA-sanctioned event. Both qualified based on their performances in the 200 and 400 freestyle, respectively, at the Dearborn meet in June.

Guy Murray stepped onto the track at Andover High School and headed toward the finish line. He checked his watch as he broke the tape and what he saw was a first-place time.

Murray, the University of Detroit Mercy cross country and track and field head coach, turned in yet another championship performance at the Heart of the Hills 10- and five-kilometer runs. The Livonia resident (formerly of Farmington Hills) won his third 10K at the 16th annual event July 28 in Bloomfield Hills, clocking a winning time of 32 minutes, 3 seconds.

The tradition-rich road race attracted over 800 participants this year — 507 officially finished the challenging 10K, while another 330 completed the 5K — and they were greeted by a temperature in the 60s, partly cloudy skies and light winds.

It was a far cry from some of the sweltering conditions present in years past. Murray, 34, assumed the lead for good near the four-mile mark en route to his first Heart of the Hills 10K triumph since 1995 when he finished in 33:02. He also won the 10K race (33:44) in 1992.

"It was definitely one of the better days to run, compared with some of the hot and humid

days we've had here in the past," said Murray, who recorded the fifth fastest winning 10K time since the course was changed in 1993. "I felt OK, not great, but OK."

"It's a good event, it's well organized and it's definitely a challenge," added Murray, whose other road race accomplishments this summer included a victory in the three-mile run at the Motor City Striders Summer Racing Series and a third place at the Firecracker Mile. "I think the tradition of the Heart of the Hills event has a lot to do with (the big turnout) and I know people like to test their ability on this course."

David Chomet of Berkley

placed second overall in the 10K, just 12 seconds behind Murray, and Milford's Tom Greenless posted a 32:27 as he took third for the second straight year.

Keith Stopen of Rochester was fourth (33:03). He was 11th in last year's U.S. Olympic men's marathon trials, while Murray finished in the top 35.

Laurel Park of Ann Arbor proved to be the class in the 10K women's division as she clocked a winning time of 37:16, good for 24th overall.

Oxford's Adam Frezza, 18, emerged as the overall 5K winner in a time of 16 minutes, 3 seconds. The top female finisher was Michelle Ruggiero of Shelby Township (18:46).
