Repentance Is Good for the Soul

Psalm 32 is a wonderful psalm about the forgiveness that God displays when we are repentant for our sins. It says in part: "Happy are those whose sins are forgiven, whose wrongs are pardoned. Happy is the man whom the Lord does not accuse of doing wrong and who is free from all deceit. When I did not confess my sins I was worn out from crying all day long. Then I confessed my sins to you; I did not conceal my wrong doings. I decided to confess them to you and you forgave all my sins." This psalm reflects the great love that God has for us; however, when we sin and have no remorse, we are opposing God. It is important for us to be sorry and repentant for our wrongdoing as soon as we realize that we have sinned. We should ask our Heavenly Father for forgiveness, make an honest effort to refrain from sinning and, whenever possible, try to make amends for whatever wrong we have done. The Bible tells us that God is ever ready to forgive our transgressions, and keep us in His unmerited favor.
