

Shaw adds to record in Clarenceville's 46-6 triumph

Tim Shaw didn't gain a yard in the second half against Lutheran High School Westland. But then, he didn't have any carries, either.

The Livonia Clarenceville running back had already run for 224 yards on just seven rushes Friday night in the Trojans' 46-6 victory over Lutheran Westland.

He topped his state record touchdown total to 105 with scoring runs of 62, 21 and 68 yards as the Trojans (6-0, 5-0) scored the first six times they had the ball and seven of their 10 first-half possessions.

The Trojans were even into a little trickery as Coach Greg Hudkins begins the countdown to the playoffs.

Quarterback Pete Shaw lined up with his back to the line and the ball was snapped to a deep back, who then pitched the ball to Shaw so he could sweep to the right and throw a pass down field. In this case it worked for a 14-yard gain to Bill Nesbitt.

"We scored a touchdown off that play last week," Hudkins said. "When I played in college

we played Denison and they used the old single wing."

So Hudkins adapted it to his own personnel — and it's clearly a play that's going to cause somebody problems in the post-season when used at a critical juncture.

"We've got smart kids," Hudkins said, "so we can make some adjustments. We still use the same basic plays."

Pete Shaw had a marvelous passing night, completing all passes he threw — six to his team and one to Lutheran Westland. His throws gained 114 yards, including a 34-yard touchdown pass to Steve Meadows.

Meadows had runs of 1- and 25-yards for scores while Aaron Allison had a 1-yard scoring run.

But while Tim Shaw's touchdown exploits may be getting him attention all over the state and country, they aren't attracting much notice just down the road in Ann Arbor.

If the University of Michigan is recruiting Shaw, they're doing it invisibly.

"They didn't even ask for film this year," Hudkins said. "I guess they're not interested."

Penn State is, though. So is Michigan State, which had George Perles' son in attendance, and so is Notre Dame.

Shaw intends to take a visit to Stanford, too, which his 3.9 grade point will allow him to do.

While most of the Division I schools view Shaw as a linebacker, because of his state champion sprinter speed, the Spartans' view him as a possible running back because of that and the linebacker size of about 220 pounds he'll bring to the campus.

Hudkins played his second string the second half and Lutheran Westland picked up the tempo a good bit.

"They're a top-ranked team in the state," Warriors coach Gary Kamin said. "We told our kids to just go out and play their game."

"We played better in the second half. Of course, they had their second teams in, but we still played better."

"We said at halftime that all year they've had just two touchdowns scored against them so that was our goal."

Lutheran Westland (3-3, 1-4) did score, too, on an 81-yard interception return for a TD by Mike Clark with 6:26 left. The second half was played with a running clock.

The Warriors intercepted Pete Shaw in the first play and sophomore quarterback Doug Haller nearly connected with Clark on a touchdown pass on the play after

the turnover. He couldn't quite hang on to it in the open.

"We had two touchdown passes dropped," Kamin said. "That would have shocked them."

"I really like what Greg has done with that program. They've really done a good job, from the weight room out."

Joel Wolfgram ended up leading Lutheran Westland with 36 yards rushing on nine carries. The Warriors were limited to 16 yards total offense in the first

half and were held without a first down.

Meadows gained 65 yards on just six carries while Jeff Fioret-ti ran for 109 on eight runs, all but 10 yards of that coming as Shaw's sub in the second half.

One source of worry as Hudkins begins steering the course for the future ... his team needs to be tested.

"The one thing that concerns me is that we haven't been in a whole game yet. We may have to

keep our starters in just to do that."

"They've only played into the fourth quarter just once and that was only one play. They're usually out early in the third quarter."

"It's not so much the physical I'm worried about, it's the mental. But we've got a couple of good games coming up."

Glenn nips Central in overtime thriller

It was utter pandemonium as Westland John Glenn fans and players stormed the field and mobbed each other, along with the man of the hour, Andrew Peiffer, following Friday's 24-21 overtime triumph over host Walled Lake Central.

The Rockets' faithful had a right to be giddy, running their record to 6-1 and moving within one win of a state playoff.

But more importantly, Glenn captured another Lakes Division championship and earned the right in two weeks to host mighty Farmington Hills Harrison, the state's No. 1 team, for the coveted Western Lakes Activities Association title.

The 6-foot-2, 150-pound Peiffer, who tied a school record with nine catches to go along with 194 yards, secured the OT triumph when he picked off a Central pass after booting what proved to be the game-winning 23-yard field.

"What I admire most about Andrew the most is that he plays hard all the time, it doesn't matter if it's offense or defense," said Glenn coach Chuck Gordon, who was caught with a cooler in his way for his jubilant players afterwards. "But the thing I like most about him is that he'll be there Monday at practice and be right back ready to work."

Glenn's effort was workmanlike for sure. The Rockets were trouble running the football against Central's jammed up defensive front. Glenn compiled only 81 yards in 35 attempts, but went to the air as junior quarterback Brian Czekiewicz enjoyed his best day in a Rocket uniform, completing 13 of 21 passes for 228 yards.

"We thought we had to mix it up," Gordon said. "We had to throw more, because they commit so many people to the run."

Peiffer simply outmuscled any Viking defender who got in his way for the ball. The senior made a variety of catches, but none was bigger than his 33-

yard grab on the sideline at the Central 7 late in the fourth quarter.

"I felt like I was in control the whole game and could come up with the big play," Peiffer said. "I felt real confident I could catch anything coming my way."

Peiffer's key catch and a subsequent pass interference call against the Vikings set up Czekiewicz's 1-yard touchdown sneak with only 1:09 left in regulation to cap impressive 17-play, 80-yard drive.

Peiffer, putting on his steel-toe cleat, then booted his third straight extra point to send the game into OT at 21-14.

Glenn got the ball first but was forced to go for a Peiffer field goal following a 4-yard run by DeAnthony Granberry and two incompletions.

Central then took the ball and was stuffed by a fired up Glenn defense on two rushing plays, resulting in just 3 yards.

Viking quarterback Ryan Trailer (six of 13 for 149 yards) then eyed 6-foot-2 wide receiver Maxx Morris, who had caught the go-ahead TD on an 11-yarder with 1:53 left in the third.

The ball and a Glenn defender met simultaneously at the 3 with the pigskin hanging in the air what seemed to be an eternity. Peiffer alertly made a diving grab, picking off the pass to put the game away.

With Glenn unable to stop Central's sweep, the Vikings scored first on Scott Long's 10-yard TD run with 9:35 left in the opening quarter.

Glenn came back to score 14 straight points despite two costly first-half turnovers.

Granberry's 2-yard run made it 7-7 with 7:56 to play in the second quarter. The Rockets scored again on their next possession after Bonnie Oliphant recovered a fumble at the Vikings' 27.

Three plays later, Peiffer caught a 15-yard TD pass from Czekiewicz.

Central pulled within one, 14-13, just before the half when Long scored his second TD on a 13 yard run.

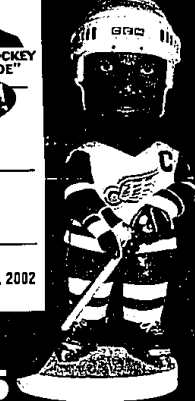
