**Thoughtless Remarks**  
How should we react when we have been verbally offended by someone? Should we humbly accept another person's inconsiderate remarks, or should we attempt to get even by insulting back? Perhaps we all occasionally are subjected to personal insults and remarks. These indignities may even be unintentional since many people are often not aware that they are being offensive. In addition, they may even think that they are helping us out by telling us that we are gaining weight or that our hair is turning gray, as if we are not aware of these conditions. We should try not to let another person's thoughtless words affect our emotions. The Bible is quite clear on how we should react when someone has offended us in one way or another. In Romans 12:19, we are told that we should not take revenge, but leave it to God. Jesus should be our example, and we should follow by not trying to get even by returning insult for insult. Instead, gently telling the person that they hurt our feelings may be the best way to handle such matters.
