**On the Matter of Cost . . .**

- OCC tuition is \$50.30 per credit hour for college district residents.
- A student enrolled full-time (13 credit hours in the fall semester; 12 credit hours in the winter semester; and 6 credit hours in the spring or summer sessions) will pay \$1,664.30 including registration and technology fees. Course fees for some classes will be extra.
- Since a typical OCC associate degree requires 62 credit hours, the cost for your degree will be about \$3,328.60. Compare that with any other public or private university - at OCC you get a quality education at one-quarter to one-half the price!

Students at other colleges and universities who come home for the summer can complete a class or two at OCC and still have plenty of time for some 'fun in the sun'.

OCC's tradition of small classes and personal attention from professors (not teaching assistants) will increase your likelihood of success in tough subjects like calculus, organic chemistry or trigonometry. And don't think the classes are watered down - OCC uses the same textbooks for most of these courses that universities do.
