TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND PERSONS:

On or about June 10, 2002 the above named City of Farmington Hills, Oakland County, will request the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to release Federal funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) for the following projects:

- Housing Rehabilitation Program to improve existing single-family housing in Farmington Hills (city-wide), Oakland County, Michigan (\$200,000.00)
- Nine Mile Storm Drain (Section 26) which includes the installation of 3,000 linear feet of 30" to 48" storm drain pipe, and ditching in the existing right-of-way (\$417,000.00) Census Tracts 1674, Block 4

It has been determined that such request for release of funds will not constitute an action significantly affecting the quality and the human environment and accordingly, the above-named Farmington Hills, Oakland County has decided not to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (PL-91-190).

The reasons for such decision not to prepare such Statement are as follows: The proposed projects will require only minor alterations to the landscape and will not destroy or interrupt natural features of the surrounding environment, such as but not limited to, water courses and wildlife.

An Environmental Review Board respecting the within project has been made by the above-named Farmington Hills, Oakland County which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets for the reasons why such Statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is on file at the above address and is available for public examination and copying, upon request at the Community Development Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted prior to the request for release of Federal funds.

All interested agencies, groups and persons disagreeing with this decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the City of Farmington Hills, Oakland County, to the City Manager at 31555 W. Eleven Mile Road, Farmington Hills, MI 48338 on or before June 7, 2002. All such comments so received will be considered and the City of Farmington Hills, Oakland County, will not request the release of Federal funds or take any administrative action on the within project prior to the date specified in the preceding sentence.

The City of Farmington Hills will undertake the project described above with Block Grant Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. Farmington Hills is certifying to HUD that Farmington Hills and Steve Brock, in his official capacity as City Manager, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision making, and action; and that these responsibilities have been decided. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, Farmington Hills may use the Block Grant Funds, and HUD will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. HUD will accept an objection to its approval of the release of funds and acceptance of the certification only if it is on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not in fact executed by the chief executive officer or other officer of applicant approved by HUD; or (b) that applicant's environmental review record for the project indicates omission of a required decision, finding, or step applicable to the project in the environmental review process. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedure (24 CFR, Part 58) and may be addressed to HUD, P. V. McNamara Federal Building, 477 Michigan Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226.

Objections to the release of funds on basis other than those stated above will not be considered by HUD. No objection received after June 25, 2002 will be considered by HUD.
