## DISABILITY AND ARTHRITIS

Any type of joint condition can lead to permanent disability. Osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, lupus arthritis, or psoriatic arthritis can attack enough joints to force you to stop working.

The difficulty you have reaching a decision to retire is equalized by the problems your doctor may face in trying to answer disability forms.

For example, the forms usually contain a question on the doctor's opinion on the extent of your disability. He may know that any sustained activity is out of the question for your hands or knees. However, the disability inquiry phrasing often asks work with soft care. Thus before you are considered unable to undertake any work, the doctor must indicate that your arm is bedridden.

Another difficult area for physicians is determining what your limits are. Physicians are unlikely to understand the conditions under which you work or the weight you carry, move, or lift. But the disability forms are full of questions about what specific tasks and weights you can handle.

When you want your doctor to complete a disability form, expect to schedule an appointment with him. The questions on the form may be obvious to you, but the answers may not be to him. Your physician needs you to provide the details of your job and the environment in which you work. Only then can he complete those forms in a manner fair to you and to the organization taking financial responsibility to provide you compensation.
