approaches. The issue arose at a recent meeting when resident Mark Johnston questioned the council about the city golf course expansion at San Marino. She has long been an opponent of development on the 11 Pines property, including a 23-acre landfill the city is capping as part of the development. After giving Johnston 2-

minute warnings to wrap up her speech, Bates unexpectedly announced a 2-minute recess.

At the same meeting, Bates allowed resident Mark Gordinier to address the council for more than a half hour. Johnston later complained about the action, and city manager Steve Brook agreed to meet with her at a later date to address her specific concerns.
