who placed sixth in recurve at last year's tournament, also returns; McGlyn is currently ranked second in the nation, trailing only Johnson.

In Senior Women's Recurve, top-ranked Kathy Loesch — the defending champion — is one of the few top shooters who won't be competing. Loesch is recovering from a back injury.

Karen Scavotto, the runner-up in women's recurve last year and currently ranked second in the nation, will be the favorite in her division, but like Johnson in the men's recurve, she will face a formidable field. Among the leading challengers is Jessica Carleton of Redford, who placed fifth at last year's championships and is currently ranked fourth in the country.

Also back will be Dave Cousins, the defending champ in Senior Men's Compound,

and Sally Wunderle, the reigning champ in Senior Women's Compound.

The format for both compound and recurve is the same. In men's competition, there are two separate rounds, with archers shooting at distances of 90, 70, 50 and 30 meters, 18 arrows at each distance — a total of 144 arrows. Women shoot two rounds as well, but at three distances, 70, 60 and 30 meters, 18 arrows at each, a total of 108 arrows.

Competition for the U.S. Nationals title in both recurve and compound will be from 8 a.m. until approximately 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday of next week. On Friday (Aug. 2), the single-elimination U.S. Open Tournament in men's and women's recurve and compound will be held.

Admission to all events is free.

## Rams begin quest for NABF World Series title

The Michigan Rams 16-and-under baseball team begins its quest for the National Amateur Baseball Federation World Series title today in Northville.

The Rams, 40-6-3 this season and 13-0 in the Little Caesars Select Division, won the United States Select Sports Association state championship. They also

went 4-1 at tournaments in Indianapolis, Bowling Green, Ohio, and Fort Wayne, Ind.

The Rams beat the Kenosha Indians 14-5 to win the double-elimination Midwest Regional. The Indians had defeated the Rams earlier, 5-3. Daniel Kapala, allowed five runs in the first two innings of the title game, then shut out the Indians the rest of the way. He struck out six and gave up five hits.

The Rams went ahead for good with a run in the fourth, then added six more in the fifth. Timothy Kalczyński went 2-for-2 with three runs and three walks. Alexander Avila and Scott Cain each had two hits and three runs batted in. All nine starters had at least one hit.

The Rams have competed in three AABC championships and the CABA World Series.

The team has players from Farmington Hills, Canton, Garden City, Redford, West Bloomfield, Taylor, Royal Oak, Romeo and Detroit.

Kalczyński, Avila, Kyle Miller, Steven Antonioti, Martin Kelmigian and Cain all had batting averages of at least .400 this season. Six other players hit between .350 and .400.

Antonioti, Kapala, Charles Pate and Michael Hand each won five games this season. Three other pitchers won at least four.

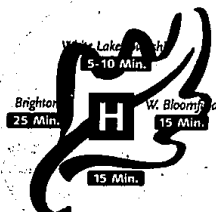

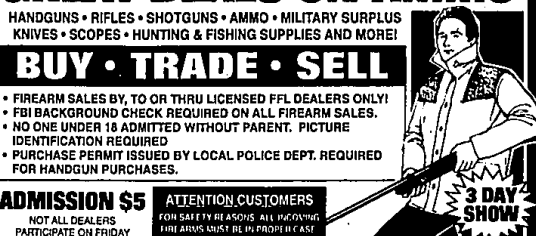
