Councilwoman Vicki Barnett said shopping carts are usually littered around the parking lots at mega-stores, and she wanted to see cart corrals that were more appealing to the eye.
An impressive facade for Sam's Club didn't look much like the original draft, pointed

out Councilman Jerry Ellis. He

out Councilman Jerry Ellis. He said he wanted to see more windows in the roof area and to lower the proposed parking spaces for the store.

"I never see those lots more than one-third full," he said. "Even during the holidays." He favored leaving green-space that could later be removed if parking was an issue.

Sakwa pointed out that Kmart backed out of a plan to open up a Super Store for the project, which caused delays in pursuing Plane 2.


