Being Truthful



You've probably heard the saying that if you never tell a lie you will never have to worry about remembering what you said. This reflects one way in which telling a lie can produce anxiety, since we may worry about what two different people and perhaps subsequently be caught in a lie. The benefits of telling the truth are more involved than just lessening our anxiety; we also benefit from telling the truth because it creates more intimate and trusting relationships with those around us. Oftentimes it creates occasions for growth, especially when the truth is painful or difficult to express. We may frequently try to spare our loved ones from painful facts by "sugar coating" the truth or telling them "white lies". However, withholding information from people may deprive them of the ability to make informed decisions, and denies both parties to the conversation the chance to develop an honest, intimate and trusting relationship. Surely, the truth can sometimes be painful, and we should always be careful in how we express it. But the fact that someone may not live what we have to tell them, or that we feel uncomfortable telling them, is not a justification for lying.
