The chorus has toured throughout Michigan, singing songs from the CD, which was released in July.
We recently went to Croswell, north of Port Huron, where we were asked to do a patriotic concert. We do travel.
The 70-member chorus, made up of Ford employees or their close relatives, also has toured abroad. The group sang a Mass at St. Peter Basiliea in Rome five years ago. Other trips took the singers to Germany, France and Austria.
The chorus actually started out as a recreational group for employees at Ford in the 1940s, Morgan said. We are like family.
The group rehearses Monday nights at Ford's world headquarters in Dearborn. Ford employees and their families may join without an audition.
