Prouix's novel runs wild as it captures a region's history

THAT OLD ACE IN THE HOLE by Annie Prouls (Scribner, 36 pages, \$26)

Either Annie Pronk is a crafty writer indeed, or her new novel simply got away from her. In That Old Ace in the Hole, the Pulitzer Prize-winning author of The Shipping News (1994) trails the insertutable Bob Dollar as he infiltrates Wrodyburset, a small town on

Prouls never does draw her many tales into a cohesive and streamlined ending. The novel has the flavor of LaVoris files: Family histories, legends and love letters mixed together and spilling out of their boxes.

But the mess Prouls has created is a charming one, and ultimately the chaotic structure of the novel proves to be the one that best fits its story.


