usually something that is regained. The patient must learn compensating skills.*

According to the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association, visual field loss occurs in many forms, from nearly complete loss of peripheral vision to small areas of partial loss. Patients who suffer strokes or other transmite brain injuries to one side of the brain, including tumors, may develop a loss of visual field to the opposite side.

"Patients often mistake this as being a bad right eye or left eye, but it actually occurs in the brain and thus presents as a loss in both eyes. Patients often run into objects, lose their place in reading and are startled by people or objects moving at them suddenly from the lost field," according to NORA. Scheele has recently been tested by her ophthalmologist for visual field loss and is awaiting the findings. Based on the test results, it possible Hahn will recommend more occupational therapy.
