**It's Never Too Late**

It is never too late to return to God. In the parable of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32), we are told of a young man returning home after leading a disolute life in a foreign land. He is welcomed home with open arms by his father, as we are by God. In another parable, Jesus speaks of laborers who are hired at different times of the day, and all are given a full day's pay (Matthew 20:1-16). This parable illustrates that God wants to reward us, regardless of when we have decided to follow Him. Finally, in the parable of the lost sheep (Matthew 18:12-14), we are told that the good shepherd will leave all of his sheep in search of the one that is lost, which indicates how much God loves and cares for each of us. In each case, we see that God's justice is not the same as man's. The brother of the prodigal son feels betrayed by his father's loving acceptance of his brother, and the laborers who worked all day feel they should be given more than those who only worked for a few hours. Is it not foolish to leave the flock to search for the one that is lost? The point of all these parables is simple: God loves us unconditionally and wants us to return to Him, no matter what we may have done or when we make the decision to live a godly life.

It was fitting to make merry and be glad, for this your brother was dead, and is alive; he was lost and is found.
