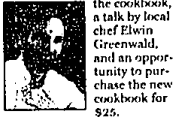

Boaters Safety
Passing this class will allow youth ages 12-16 to operate a motor boat of six-horse power or more. In addition, all people born after Dec. 31, 1978 must pass this course to operate a personal watercraft. No one under the age of 14 may legally operate a PWC.

A child 12 and over may ride a PWC with an adult if both have passed an approved boater safety class. Session choices are 6-9 p.m. April 22 and 24 or May 13 and 15. Cost is \$5 per person and you must register in advance.
