Push you to make a quick decision. Reputable contractors will provide a written estimate that will be valid for days or weeks. If the great deal they are offering you today is not available tomorrow or next week, it is probably a seam. Never hire someone on the spot. Ask for references, then check them.

Koenig important to begin each day with an efficient plan. The first hour schedule may vary because of vacations, school year, summer, week-ends or weckdays. Part of the success of the first hour is determined by the last hour the night before. You cannot leave a sink full of dishes,

stacks of paper and general clutter throughout your house if you expect the next morning to run smoothly. This might be your typical 'first hour' day: The slarm rings and you get out of bed. You tend to personal needs and make the bed. Start a load of clothes in the washer. Proceed to the kitchen where you can prepare breakfast, cat and fix lunches. After everyone has had breakfast do a final kitchen clean-up.

Put the clothes from the washer into the dryer. Next freshen up the bathrooms and empty all the trash cans. Finally finish any necessary personal needs. You are ready for the rest of the day. Whether

If you have a specific "clean-ing house day, you will have a different agenda for that day. You will not have the bathrooms because you are going to thoroughly clean them.
