U-M scientists trigger new hair growth in mice


University of Michigan graduate atudent David Van Mater knew something Atrange was going on when he noticed stubble on the shaved skin of experimental mice in his laboratory. Indeed of the tumors he had originally expected to see, the mice were growing hiair.

Van Mater had stumbled on the discovery that the actuation (hay-thi-kuh-TERN-in), a signaling protein involved in embryonic development and several types of cancer, also triggers changes in adult mous hair follicles that lead to the growth of new hair.

The discovery by Yan Mater and U-M scientists Drs. Prank T. Kolliga, Andrzej A. Dlugost and Eric R. Fearon will be published in the May 15 issue of Genes U Decelopment.

"Hair follicles are like a mini-organ in the body," explains Van Mater, a graduate student in

the U-M Medical School's Medical Scientist Training Program. 'Unlike most organs in the adult body, hair follicles go through regular cycles of growth, regression and rest. They are able to regenerate completely during each growth phase. Previous studies had suggested that a Writ signal might be the switch that driver resting hair follicles into the active growth phase. By treating the transgenic mice with a single application of 4-OHT, we hoped to mimic the effect of a short pulse of Writ expression in normal mice.

So Van Mater started over applying 4-OHT just once to the shaved backs of transgenic mice and normal mice during the telogen phase of the hair cycle. Fifteen days later, the transgenic mice needed another shave, but there were no signs of new hair growth on the control mice.

"Many hair follicles in bald and halding men are greatly Many hair foreces in balding men are greatly reduced in size, so merely reactions hair growth would not reduced in size, so merely reac-tivating hair growth would not produce a normal hair, Also, activation of beta-catenin in the body would need to be tightly regulated, since uncontrolled beta-catenia activity can lead to tumors of hair follicle cells or tumors in other sites, such as the colon, liver or ovary."

said. "In pregnant women on thyroid hormone, the need increases significantly in the third month of pregnancy. Retrospective studies have been done which tested IQ-9 of bables. Of 1,000 women, 64 were hypothyroid, and those women's infants had significantly decreased IQ-8.

"The main test we use (to diagnose hypothyroidism) is (a) pituitary (function) test, (which tells whether) there is or is not enough thyroid hormone there. Most endocrinologists treat hypothyroidism with one of four synthetic products containing thyroine (T4), a hormone secreted by the thyroid; said Thylor, who doesn't treat people with low to normal thyroid levels because he believes the tests are too sensitive.

He also said a low level of thyroid hormone may be the culprit in many cases of infertility. Brownstein explained that the thyroid gland produces two major hormones: Thyroxine (T4) and Thiodothyronine (T3), both of which influence the renergy work of the cells in all the body's organs.
