

Proceedings of Annual Meeting and Itemized Financial Report, District No. 5 Fractional Farmington, Livonia and Redford Townships—Clarenceville Schools

July 8, 1929

Meeting called to order by the President, Mr. Headerle.

All members of the Board present with the exception of Mr. Tabor, and about 100 voters.

Minutes of the Annual Meeting were read and approved.

Report of 1928-29 read.

Motion by Mrs. Billings, supported by Mrs. Witte, next year's report be mimeographed and handed out to voters, at the next annual meeting and each annual meeting thereafter. Motion carried.

Election of trustees—two to be elected.

Mr. Charles Hulse nominated Mr. Elmer Doherty as trustee to succeed Mr. Wm. Thornton. Nomination supported by Mrs. Billings.

Tellers of election, Mr. Getts and Mr. Billings.

Motion by Mr. Witte, supported by Mrs. Billings, nominations be closed. Motion carried.

No. of votes cast, 90. Mr. Doherty, 84; Mr. Thornton, 6. Mr. Doherty declared elected.

Motion by Mrs. Getts, supported by Mr. Jones, Mr. Witte be nominated as trustee to succeed Mr. Tabor.

Motion by Mrs. Mack, supported by Mrs. Kaldor, Mr. Thornton be nominated.

Motion by Mrs. Carnahan, supported by Mrs. Zobl, Mr. Sauve be nominated.

Ballots cast, 92: Mr. Thornton, 22; Mr. Witte, 30; Mr. Sauve, 38; Mr. Lee, 1; Spoiled, 1.

Mr. Sauve declared elected.

Officers salaries. Motion by Mr. Utujian, supported by Mr. Thornton, treasurer's salary be reduced to \$100.00 for ensuing year.

Motion by Mr. Cation, supported by Mr. Billings, amount of treasurer's salary remain at \$200.

Motion by Mr. McFarland, supported by Mr. Kaldor, salaries for remaining officers remain the same as last year. Motion carried.

School Term. Motion by Mr. Witte, supported by Mrs. Billings, the school term remain the same. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Witte, supported by Mr. Getts, free text books be furnished as heretofore. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Kaldor, supported by Mrs. Witte, excess tuition be paid to eligible high school in Michigan. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Witte, supported by Mr. Getts, depository remain the same for ensuing year. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Utujian, supported by Mrs. Witte, the sum of \$3833.33 in building fund be transferred to general fund. Motion carried.

Eight o'clock hour of meeting for next annual meeting.

There being no further business, motion made to adjourn. Carried.
